To the Praise of His Glory (II)

(Continued From Last Week)

Yet another way of glorifying God and, at the same time, demonstrating we are Jesus' disciples is through bearing fruit. (Jn. 15:8; See vss. 1-8) Jesus used the agricultural illustration of the vine and the branches to teach about our relationship with Him. We draw our life from being connected to Him; and God trims and prunes everything that would hinder us from bearing fruit and achieving the results He desires. One way of bearing fruit is accomplished through teaching and preaching the gospel. Jesus commanded that we should go and make disciples of all nations, (Matt. 28:18-20; Mk. 16:15-16) In our evangelistic efforts, we are in partnership with God. We planters and water; and God gives the growth. (1 Cor. 3:5-9) As people come to faith through obedience to the gospel, fruit is produced. (Matt. 13:2-9, 18-23; cf. Is. 55:9-11).

However, numerical growth is not the only kind of fruit that is produced. Making disciples involves growing spiritually as well. (Matt. 28:20) Peter prayed on behalf of the Philippians that their love might "... abound still more and more in real knowledge and discernment, so that you may approve the things that are excellent, in order to be sincere and blameless until the day of Christ; having been filled with the fruit of righteousness which comes through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God." (Phil. 1:9-11) We are to grow in grace and knowledge and to develop a Christ-like character. (2 Pet. 3:17, 18; Rom. 8:29; Gal.

2:20). God gives the Spirit to all who obey (Acts 2:38, 39; 5:32). The Spirit dwells within us; and is the guaranteeing deposit of our eternal inheritance (1 Cor. 3:16; 6:19; Eph. 2:21, 22; 2 Cor. 1:21, 22; 5:1-5; Eph. 1:13, 14). The Spirit helps us live the life God desires and is proof that we belong to God. (Rom. 8:1-17). His presence is evidenced by various character traits called the fruit of the spirit that He helps us produce. (Gal. 5:22-25). Peter tells us that such qualities help us live effectively and ensure our eternal salvation. (2 Pet. 1:5-11).

Lastly, we glorify God through bearing up under suffering; especially suffering for the cause of Christ. Following his resurrection, Jesus spoke with Peter at the seashore telling him how he would glorify God in his death. (Jn. 21:19) Peter told his readers that they were being shielded by the power of God until the last day when they would receive the anticipated promised inheritance. In the meantime, they would have to face various trials that their faith might be proved genuine resulting in praise, glory and honour when Christ is revealed. (1 Pet. 1:6, 7). Suffering of one kind or another is inevitable. However, if our suffering is due to the fact we are Christians, we should not be ashamed; but, rather, glorify God in the matter. (1 Pet. 4:16; cf. Lk. 6:22, 23)

Whatever we do, whether in word or deed should be done with the authority of Christ and as his representative and ambassador (Col. 3:17) because now or at some point in the future every knee will bow and every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord to the glory of God, the Father. (Phil. 2:11)
