



### Covid Restrictions being lifted:

1. Masking - **masking is no longer required** (you may wear a mask if you choose to do so)
2. **All services will be run simultaneously with ZOOM**
3. **Sunday morning Bible Study will return at 10 am Sunday (March 27)**
4. Wednesday Night Bible Study is STILL RUNNING as usual, but it is still to be determined if we will be returning to the building.
5. Coffee machine will be available at the back of auditorium.

Covid restrictions remaining will be revisited at the end of April:

- Hymns will still be done on the screen
- Communion will be taken from the 'all in one cups' available at the entrances.

## *Acts 26: 19 - 32*

### Paul Defense Before Agrippa

<sup>19</sup> “Therefore, O King Agrippa, I was not disobedient to the heavenly vision, <sup>20</sup> but declared first to those in Damascus, then in Jerusalem and throughout all the region of Judea, and also to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to God, performing deeds in keeping with their repentance. <sup>21</sup> For this reason the Jews seized me in the temple and tried to kill me.

<sup>22</sup> To this day I have had the help that comes from God, and so I stand here testifying both to small and great, saying nothing but what the prophets and Moses said would come to pass: <sup>23</sup> that the Christ must suffer and that, by being the first to rise from the dead, he would proclaim light both to our people and to the Gentiles.”

<sup>24</sup> And as he was saying these things in his defense, Festus said with a loud voice, “Paul, you are out of your mind; your great learning is driving you out of your mind.” <sup>25</sup> But Paul said, “I am not out of my mind, most excellent Festus, but I am speaking true and rational words. <sup>26</sup> For the king knows about these things, and to him I speak boldly. For I am persuaded that none of these things has escaped his notice, for this has not been done in a corner. <sup>27</sup> King Agrippa, do you believe the prophets? I know that you believe.” <sup>28</sup> And Agrippa said to Paul, “In a short time would you persuade me to be a Christian?”

<sup>29</sup> And Paul said, “Whether short or long, I would to God that not only you but also all who hear me this day might become such as I am—except for these chains.”

<sup>30</sup> Then the king rose, and the governor and Bernice and those who were sitting with them. <sup>31</sup> And when they had withdrawn, they said to one another, “This man is doing nothing to deserve death or imprisonment.” <sup>32</sup> And Agrippa said to Festus, “This man could have been set free if he had not appealed to Caesar.”

**Entrance will be by the Fennell Avenue door. Please exit by the doors on the East 27th entrance. Those who require the Ramp entrance off the parking lot may use this entrance to enter and exit the building.**
