When you enter from the Fennell entrance, there will be communion items available on the table. Please pick up your Communion cups which will contain a bread wafer and grape juice and proceed to the seating area. If you prefer to bring your own communion items, you are welcome to do that. Please choose your seat while being particular to social distance from other members.

Masks are no longer required within the church building, but you may wear a mask if you wish.

If you do not have one, there will a supply of masks available for members to use. We will not be singing during the worship time, but some Acapella music will be played.

If you are not feeling well, please stay home. The worship service will be available on Zoom and you are welcome to join the Zoom meeting
